Which Activities Are Not Eligible:

- Any activity where you are paid (i.e. babysitting, part-time job, etc.)
- Job shadowing or a work experience component of a course
- Co-operative education experiences
- · Any required activities of a course or program in which you can earn a credit
- Playing on a school or recreational sports team
- Activities which are regular family responsibilities (i.e. farm chores, laundry)
- · Court-ordered community service programs, alternative measures program or any diversionary program that uses community service
- · The handling of hazardous wastes
- Any activity involving the operation of a vehicle or power tools
- Any activity that requires knowledge of a tradesperson (i.e. auto mechanic)
- · Any Activity involving banking, securities or other valuables
- Any activity unsafe, unsupervised environment (i.e. scaffolding)
